Peter DeGroot is a Managing Director and heads J.P. Morgan’s Municipal Research and Strategies efforts.

J.P. Morgan’s Municipal Research Group publishes daily and weekly market analytics and commentary for issuer and investor clients. The team also advises the firm’s investor clients on risk and performance management in tax-exempt and taxable municipal bond portfolios. Peter joined J.P. Morgan in June of 2011 from Barclays Capital where he was a Managing Director and head of the municipal strategies team.

Mr. DeGroot regularly speaks at industry events and is often cited in the financial press. He was voted the top ranked municipal bond strategist from 2003 through 2010 and again from 2012 through 2016, based on the annual survey by *Institutional Investor*.
